Fast Track Compressed Air Incentives



What's eligible?

TVA EnergyRight® for Business & Industry is offering incentives for the following types of compressed air equipment:

- \$300 per unit No Loss Condensate Drains
 - Eligible for the replacement of timed drains and/or manually opened drains only.
 - Eligible for compressed air systems whose rated horse-power (HP) is at 50 HP and above.
 - Compressed air system HP shall not include redundant, backup, or out-of-service compressors.

\$75 per unit - Engineered Air Nozzles

- Eligible for the replacement of standard air nozzles and/or open air guns.
- *Engineered air nozzle must meet SCFM rating at 80psig less than or equal to:

Nozzle Diameter:	1/8"	1/4"	5/16"	1/2"
Max SCFM Rating @ 80psig:	11	29	56	140

*Not limited to sizes listed in the table.

\$8 per HP/unit - Low Pressure Drop Filters

- Compressed air system HP shall not include redundant, backup, or out-of-service compressors.
- Eligible for replacement of standard coalescing filters with low pressure drop filters.

\$4 per cfm/shift - Cycling Refrigerated Dryers

- Eligible for replacement of non-cycled refrigerated dryers with cycled refrigerated dryers.
- The addition of controls to existing dryers does not qualify.
- The replacement of desiccant, deliquescent, heat-of-compression, membrane, or other types of dryers does not qualify.
- Recommended for units to be rated less than 0.60 kW/100cfm.

Shift Type	1-Shift	2-Shift	3-Shift
Incentive Rate Per CFM	\$4	\$8	\$12

Table illustrates the incentive values per CFM and shift type.

How are Fast Track Incentives different than Standard Incentives?

• No pre-approval required, ideal for projects with short timelines.

· Apply up to 180 days after installation.

Rules & Guidelines

- · Pre-approval is NOT required.
- · Projects may receive a post inspection.
- Incentives are limited at 70% of material, design and engineering costs.
- Project incentive must be \$150 or greater.
- Fast Track Compressed Air Incentives are only eligible for industrial customers.
- Equipment must be installed prior to submitting incentive application.
- Incentive applications can be submitted up to 6 months (180 days) after dated invoice or final install date.
