

Power REC Program Guidelines

January 1, 2027

General Participation Requirements

- The Power REC Program (“**Program**”) is designed to offer end-use customers the option to purchase renewable energy certificates, and/or blocks, from renewable energy generation sources including solar photovoltaic, wind turbines, low-impact hydro, and/or methane gas sources (which generation sources are collectively referred to as “**Green Power Sources**”).
- Customers of Distributor who participate in the Program (“**Participants**”) will enter appropriate arrangements with Distributor providing for the premium payment for energy blocks of renewable energy (“**REC Energy Blocks**”).
- Participants are required to purchase a minimum of 2,000 REC Energy Blocks annually.
- Participants may not purchase more than 105% of their typical annual electricity consumption and/or no greater than 500,000 RECs.
- TVA requires a one-year, annual enrollment to participate in the Program. Open enrollment will commence September 14, 2026, through November 09, 2026.
- Participants must re-enroll each calendar year by signing the Power REC Enrollment form. Participants who want to terminate their participation in the Program or who want to modify the quantity of REC Energy Blocks purchased may do so by notifying their Distributor.
- Current participants who fail to complete re-enrollment during the open enrollment period will not be awarded RECs and will be removed from the Power REC program.

Administration

- TVA will retire RECs associated with each Participant’s purchase annually, equal to the amount of payment that is collected from the Participant.
- TVA will provide a one-time \$250.00 credit to Distributor for each new Participant that enrolls in the Program to compensate for Program costs. TVA will apply such credit(s) to Distributor’s monthly wholesale bill for power and energy.
- TVA may publish information about the Participant’s REC Energy Block purchase and participation in the Program, but TVA will honor all written requests made by Participants to keep that information confidential to the extent permitted by law.
- Participants permitted to enroll after open enrollment period for Calendar Year 2027 must still meet the minimum annual purchase (2,000 REC Blocks) and comply with all other general participation requirements. Enrollment requests received after open enrollment period end will be subject to availability.
- TVA may periodically revise the Program’s eligibility requirements upon at least 30 days’ written notice to Participant and Distributor.
- TVA may promote and advertise the Program.
- TVA will review REC Energy Block pricing and sizing for the Program annually and may change pricing or REC Energy Block sizing upon at least 30 days’ written notice to Distributor and Participant. The new REC Energy Block pricing and/or sizing will apply only to new Participants or re-enrollment in the Program.
- TVA may, upon providing at least 30 days’ written notice to Distributor, update or change any Program terms, conditions, guidelines, incentives, or requirements.
